## Supply List

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### BORDERS

A beautiful border can add so much to your quilt. Sometimes a simple frame is appropriate, but more often a stunning border can enhance, balance and add interest to the piece. There are literally hundreds of border options both pieced and appliquéd. In the two 4 week sessions we will learn how to make 10 different border patterns, making a 36" wide strip of each. These can then be pieced together to make a lap quilt as shown in the class sample, or they can be modified to fit your own projects.

BORDERS 1 Flying Geese and Sawtooth  
Square Within a Square and Shaded Sawtooth  
Spirals  
Spikes and Curves

BORDERS 2 Large and small triangles and Twisted Ribbon  
Vine and Leaves  
Celtic Knots  
Pickledish

### SUPPLIES

Freezer Paper

Pencils

Ruler-Rotary cutter and mat

Paper Scissors

Sewing machine and usual basic sewing supplies

### FABRIC:

Enough dark colored fabrics to equal 1 yard

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IDEA: Bring enough scrap fabric for your borders and to share/trade with others in the class for a real scrappy look.
